Overview:

- The Nurse Assistant Training is an examination preparatory course designed to prepare you to sit for the State Exam as a "Challenger". This means that you will not receive a diploma that allows employers to hire you prior to taking your state exam. The cost of the exam is included in the price of the class.
- Attendance to every class is critical. Due to the length of the course, there will not be any make-up time. Absenteeism causes you to be held back as lessons and skills are learned "progressively".
- You will receive verification that you attended the Nurse Assistant preparatory course. You will also receive certificates in CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer, Standard First Aid and Preventing Disease Transmission (Bloodborne Pathogens). Attendance is mandatory to receive certification in these components.
- Students are **REQUIRED** to purchase a set of red scrubs from Bosso's Uniform Company in Pensacola (850.438.7608). American Red Cross will reimburse you for the scrubs.
- Books and Stethoscopes will be provided to all students.
- Students must also provide a Medical Statement and TB Test results from their doctor during the first week of class.
